Shreveport Police Issue Arrest Warrants in Separate Theft Cases

Theft can take many forms — from check fraud to stolen vehicles — and Shreveport Police are working diligently to hold offenders accountable.

In one case, detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's White Collar Crimes Unit have obtained an arrest warrant for Kadarius Johnson. Johnson is accused of attempting to cash a check for \$4,800 — a check that was originally issued to him in May 2025 for just \$649. Upon investigation, detectives determined the check had been forged. Johnson is now wanted for one count of Forgery.

In a separate case, Stacy Flores is facing multiple charges after she allegedly stole a vehicle in June and took it to a local salvage yard to have it scrapped. Detectives say Flores provided a sworn affidavit falsely claiming ownership of the vehicle. Warrants have been issued for Flores for Theft of a Motor Vehicle, Illegal Possession of Stolen Things, and Theft.
