Disorderly Conduct Call Leads to Arrest and Drug Charges

On Friday, July 18th, just after 10:00 a.m., Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to a business in the 6600 block of Bert Kouns Industrial Loop regarding a disorderly individual.

Upon arrival, officers encountered a female—identified as Nita Capps—who was outside the establishment, repeatedly honking her vehicle's horn and refusing to leave the property. Officers attempted to de-escalate the situation and asked Capps to leave, but she began yelling profanities and claimed she would have the officers terminated.

As officers continued trying to resolve the situation, Capps placed her vehicle in reverse and struck one of the officers on scene. She was quickly taken into custody, treated by medical personnel, and then booked into the Shreveport City Jail.

While in custody, Capps continued making threats toward officers and was found to be in possession of multiple types of narcotics. She now faces the following charges:

- Battery of a police officer
- Two counts of Possession of narcotics
