## Shreveport Police Department Seeks Domestic Violence Offenders

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to addressing and reducing instances of domestic violence in our community. Domestic violence is a serious issue that affects individuals and families across all neighborhoods, and SPD detectives are working tirelessly to bring offenders to justice and support victims.

Our Domestic Violence Unit has issued warrants for the following individuals in connection with recent domestic incidents:

- Antonio Jones is wanted for the following offenses:
  - One count of Domestic Abuse Battery by Strangulation
  - One count of Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment
  - One count of Domestic Abuse Battery – 3rd OffenseJones is a known repeat offender with a documented history of domestic violence.
- Edward Raymondo is wanted for:
  - Four counts of Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment
  - One count of Cruelty to a JuvenileRaymondo is accused of striking one of his children with a beer bottle and grabbing her by the throat.
- Tyrone Davis is wanted for:
  - Battery of a Dating Partner by Strangulation
  - Battery of a Dating Partner with a Dangerous Weapon Inflicting Serious Bodily InjuryDavis is accused of violently assaulting a female partner with a blunt object, causing serious injuries to her face.

Domestic violence incidents are unfortunately increasing in our community. As a society, we must not allow this behavior to go unchecked.
