SPD Arrests Woman for Aggravated Battery Following Domestic Incident

On July 29, 2025, Shreveport Police Department Domestic Violence detectives were notified of a stabbing victim being treated at LSU Ochsner Hospital. The male victim, who sustained multiple stab wounds to his back, was reported to be in stable condition with non-life-threatening injuries.

During the investigation, the victim informed detectives that his female roommate, identified as 31-year-old Jerrica Hamilton, had consumed an unknown narcotic and began exhibiting erratic and aggressive behavior toward him and her 11-year-old daughter. In an attempt to de-escalate the situation, the victim left the residence.

Shortly after leaving, the victim began receiving threatening calls and text messages from Hamilton, indicating she intended to destroy his personal belongings. Concerned, he returned to the residence to retrieve his items. Upon his return, the victim reported being physically assaulted by Hamilton—first being struck in the head, then pepper sprayed in the face. He then felt multiple stab wounds to his back and side as he attempted to flee the home.

The victim managed to run to a nearby street, where he realized a knife was still lodged in his side. He removed the weapon and collapsed, where he was later found and transported for medical treatment.

On July 31, 2025, the original responding officer located Jerrica Hamilton. She was taken into custody without incident and booked into the Shreveport City Jail on one count of Aggravated Second Degree Battery.
