## Shreveport Police Arrest Multiple Suspects Following Firearm Crime Crackdown at Clear Horizons Apartments

Shreveport, LA – At the direction of Shreveport Police Chief Wayne Smith, officers with the Shreveport Police Department, in collaboration with the Shreveport City Marshal's Office, conducted a targeted operation to address ongoing firearm-related crimes at the Clear Horizons Apartments located at 4305 Illinois Street.

After receiving numerous complaints, law enforcement officials formulated a coordinated plan to curb criminal activity in the area. On July 29, officers arrived at apartments G-65 and F-51 to execute arrest warrants and engage with occupants. As a result of the operation, multiple individuals were taken into custody for various offenses, including firearm and narcotics violations.

### Arrested Individuals:

- **Patricia Metcalf** (DOB 01/11/1974)
  - Possession of Schedule I narcotics, Possession of Schedule II narcotics & Illegal carrying of a weapon with a controlled dangerous substance
- **Steven Scott** (DOB 09/12/1988)
  - Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. *Scott has a criminal history that includes prior felony convictions for burglary, narcotics, and firearms-related offenses.*
- **Angelica Crowson** (DOB 08/07/1993)
  - Active warrant for theft & Three outstanding cases of child desertion
- **Russell Buffet** (DOB 09/13/1997)
  - Active warrant for manslaughter from another jurisdiction (warrant executed at time of arrest)

During the operation, officers also seized multiple firearms and illegal narcotics.

This effort is part of an ongoing initiative to reduce violent crime and improve the safety and quality of life for residents in the community. The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to proactive policing and encourages the public to report suspicious activity.
