Shooting Investigation – Peach Street Apartment Complex

On Saturday, August 16, 2025, at approximately 11:20 p.m., Shreveport Police Uniformed Patrol Officers responded to reports of a shooting at an apartment complex located at 2929 Peach Street.

Upon arrival and during the preliminary investigation, officers learned that several individuals had been gathered outside the complex when an unknown suspect began firing shots in their direction.

One victim sustained multiple gunshot wounds and was transported to Ochsner Health by the Shreveport Fire Department. A second victim later arrived at Ochsner Health by private vehicle, also suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Both victims are currently in stable condition with non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Unit responded immediately to the hospital to interview the victims. One victim reported that he had been outside in the complex when a dark-colored SUV approached and its occupants began shooting. The second victim was uncooperative and declined to provide information or pursue charges.

This investigation is ongoing. Incidents of gun violence such as this are unacceptable and will not be tolerated in our community.
