Felon with a Firearm Arrested by Shreveport Police



Clarence Dock

On August 18, 2025, Shreveport Police officers arrested 44-year-old Clarence Dock after responding to an armed person complaint in the 4300 block of Illinois Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers located Dock in possession of a firearm, which was later determined to have been stolen just hours earlier. During the encounter, Dock dropped a bag containing a white powdery substance believed to be cocaine. When questioned, Dock claimed the substance was “just medicine.”

Further investigation revealed that Dock is a convicted felon and a registered sex offender due to a prior conviction of felony carnal knowledge of a juvenile. He is prohibited from possessing a firearm. Dock also has previous convictions for domestic abuse battery by strangulation and burglary.

Dock now faces multiple charges, including:

- Theft of a firearm
- Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
- Possession of Schedule II narcotics

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to removing illegally possessed firearms from the streets and holding repeat offenders accountable.
