## Suspicious Person Call Leads to Arrest After Shots Fired at Officer

On August 28, 2025, at approximately 9:50 p.m., Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to a suspicious person/prowler call at an apartment complex in the 100 block of Southfield Road. The caller reported that someone was inside his apartment.

Upon arrival, officers began searching the area. While walking through the complex, an officer observed a male subject standing on the sidewalk. As the officer illuminated the subject with his flashlight, the individual pointed a firearm and discharged one round. The officer immediately took cover behind the complex.

The suspect was identified as Glenn Garrett (DOB: 2-25-1957), the original caller who reported the prowler. Garrett was safely taken into custody, and the firearm was recovered.

Investigators found no evidence to suggest that Garrett's apartment had been broken into. Garrett later admitted that he called 911 because he believed someone was inside his apartment. He told officers he armed himself and waited outside. Garrett further admitted that when he saw a person round the corner, he fired his weapon. Fortunately, no one was struck.

Garrett was discovered to have an outstanding city warrant for property damage. In addition to that warrant, he was charged with Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer for this incident.

The officer involved displayed great restraint under extremely dangerous circumstances. The Shreveport Police Department is thankful that no one was injured.
