Shreveport Police Identify Suspect in Stolen Vehicle Fleeing Incident

On August 23, 2025, Shreveport patrol officers were requested to assist the Bossier City Police Department in tracking a vehicle recently reported stolen. The vehicle was pinging in Shreveport, prompting officers to canvass the area.

During the search, officers located the stolen vehicle. The driver fled from patrol, driving recklessly at high speeds, running off the roadway, and nearly colliding with a patrol unit, causing officers to lose sight of the vehicle. Minutes later, another officer observed the same vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed in a different area of the city. The officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop, but the vehicle again failed to yield and continued to drive recklessly.

Through further investigation and interviews with witnesses, Curite Adams was positively identified as the suspect who stole the vehicle in Bossier City and fled from Shreveport officers. Investigators also determined that after stealing the vehicle, Adams and several co-conspirators drove around Shreveport, throwing the victim's belongings alongside the Interstate and damaging the vehicle in an effort to conceal its identifying information.

Adams currently has active warrants for:

- 2 counts of Aggravated Flight from an Officer
- 1 count of Illegal Possession of Stolen Things over \$25,000
- 1 count of Obstruction of Justice

Investigators note that Adams has ties to Tyler, TX, and Dallas, TX.
