Parking Dispute Leads to Battery Arrest

On September 11, 2025, Shreveport Police officers responded to the 100 block of East Robinson Place in reference to an assault and battery call.

Upon arrival, officers made contact with the victim, who reported that he had been involved in a verbal dispute with his neighbor, 30-year-old Kappy E. Joe III (DOB 05/02/1995), regarding a parking spot on the street. During the altercation, Joe allegedly began yelling at the victim's wife. When the victim intervened, Joe struck him in the face, causing the victim to lose two teeth.

Officers placed Joe under arrest for Second Degree Battery. During the course of the investigation, it was also discovered that Joe had an outstanding warrant from Harris County, Texas. He was booked into the Shreveport City Jail.
