Murder Arrest Made

On September 29, 2025, at approximately 11:30 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers responded to reports of gunfire near the intersection of Egan Street and Gilbert Street. Upon arrival, officers located a vehicle in the 400 block of Egan Street with multiple bullet holes. Inside the vehicle, officers discovered 55-year-old Gerald Damon Washington, who had sustained multiple gunshot wounds.

Officers immediately removed Mr. Washington from the vehicle and rendered life-saving measures. Despite their efforts, he succumbed to his injuries at the scene.

On September 30, 2025, investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit conducted follow-up interviews and located additional witnesses. Based on the information gathered, detectives were able to identify a suspect. Following further investigation, 27-year-old Eric Sullivan Jr. (2-25-1998) was developed as the alleged shooter. Sullivan was subsequently charged with one count of Second Degree Murder and booked into the Shreveport City Jail.

The Shreveport Police Department commends the responding officers and detectives for their swift and thorough work in this case.
