

SPD Searching for Multiple Domestic Violence Suspects

The Shreveport Police Department is actively searching for several individuals wanted in connection with domestic violence cases across the city. As October marks *Domestic Violence Awareness Month*, the department remains committed to raising awareness, supporting survivors, and holding offenders accountable for their actions.

Detectives are currently searching for Danny Brazil in connection with an incident that occurred in August. Brazil is accused of committing intentional force or violence upon a female victim in the presence of a child under the age of 13. He is wanted for one count of Domestic Abuse Battery (2nd Offense) and one count of Battery of a Dating Partner with Child Endangerment.

Officers are also seeking Stacey Summers in connection with an incident that occurred on July 31. Summers is accused of committing force in the presence of two juveniles under the age of 13. He is wanted for two counts of Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment and one count of Domestic Abuse Battery of a Pregnant Victim.

Additionally, detectives are searching for Deshun Dinkins following an incident that occurred on September 22. Dinkins is accused of attacking the mother of his child in the presence of their nine-month-old. During the assault, the victim sustained injuries to both eyes after being struck multiple times. Dinkins has an extensive criminal history, including six prior arrests for domestic-related offenses. Warrants have been issued for one count of Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment and one count of Domestic Abuse Battery (2nd Offense).

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of these individuals to come forward. Domestic violence is not a private matter—it's a community issue that too often ends in tragedy.
