Domestic Violence Arrest



Brown

The Shreveport Police Department has arrested a man for violating a protective order following a domestic-related incident.

On the above date, SPD patrol officers responded to a call regarding a domestic disturbance in the 2800 block of Alkay Drive. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a male identified as Mr. Brown and a female victim. Both parties initially stated that they had only been engaged in a verbal disagreement. The victim reported that Mr. Brown had come to the residence briefly to drop off their child and denied that any physical altercation occurred.

During the investigation, officers learned that a permanent protective order was in place prohibiting Mr. Brown from having contact with the victim. Brown admitted to being aware of the protective order and acknowledged knowing the victim was present at the residence.

Records show that Brown previously pleaded guilty to Domestic Abuse Aggravated Assault on November 3, 2021, at which time the permanent protective order was issued.

As a result of this investigation, a warrant was issued for one count of Violation of a Protective Order. On October 13, 2025, Brown turned himself in to the Caddo Correctional Center.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to protecting victims of domestic violence and holding offenders accountable. Anyone experiencing domestic violence or in need of assistance is urged to contact local authorities.
