Shreveport Police Make Multiple Firearm-Related Arrests

The Shreveport Police Department continues to work diligently to ensure the safety of our community by addressing incidents involving the unlawful use or possession of firearms.

On October 18th, just after 7:00 p.m., officers arrested Niquirie Anderson following an incident in which she was accused of threatening individuals with a firearm. Fortunately, no one was injured. Anderson has been charged with one count of aggravated assault with a firearm.

Earlier that same evening, around 5:00 p.m., officers responded to a separate call regarding a man acting disorderly. Upon arrival, officers located the individual, identified as Roberts, who was disturbing others in the area. He was charged with one count of disturbing the peace. Further investigation revealed he was negligently carrying a concealed handgun, which was seized by officers. Roberts was subsequently charged with one count of negligent carrying of a weapon.

In a separate incident on October 22nd, just after 9:00 p.m., patrol officers responded to reports of shots fired. Officers located and arrested Frankie Johnson in connection with the incident. Thankfully, no one was injured. Johnson has been charged with one count of illegal use of a weapon.

The Shreveport Police Department strongly supports the rights of citizens to bear arms; however, those rights must be exercised safely and lawfully. Firearms should never be used to threaten others or discharged without just cause.
