Early Stages of Homicide Investigation

The Shreveport Police Department is in the early stages of a homicide investigation.

On November 4, 2025, at approximately 10:21 p.m., Shreveport Police patrol officers and Shreveport Fire Department medics responded to reports of a shooting in the 300 block of West 73rd Street. Upon arrival, officers located a 19-year-old male on the front porch of the residence suffering from a gunshot wound to his upper body.

SFD medics rendered aid on scene before transporting the victim to Ochsner LSU Health with life-threatening injuries. Despite lifesaving efforts, the victim was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival.

The Caddo Parish Coroner's Office was notified, and additional Shreveport Police Violent Crimes investigators and Crime Scene Investigators were requested. Detectives learned that multiple individuals were inside the residence at the time of the shooting. Witnesses were transported to the Violent Crimes Office for interviews, and the scene was documented and processed.
