Multiple Arrests Made in Separate Domestic Violence Incidents



Shreveport, LA — The Shreveport Police Department has made several arrests in unrelated domestic violence investigations occurring over the past several weeks. Each case involved swift action by responding officers and detectives to ensure the safety of victims—many of whom were children present during the incidents.

Arrest of Keiala McHenry

Officers responded to a report in which the victim stated his girlfriend, Keiala McHenry, pointed a firearm at him during an altercation. A child under the age of 13 was present, along with additional witnesses who provided corroborating statements.

McHenry was taken into custody and transported to the Shreveport City Jail for the charge of:

- 14:37.7D Domestic Abuse Aggravated Assault – Child Endangerment Law

Arrest of Suzanna Smith

On September 10, 2025, officers were called to 3066 Burson Drive, where the victim reported that his girlfriend, Suzanna Smith (W/F, DOB 05/13/1997), struck him multiple times in the face following a verbal argument. The victim also reported a history of prior unreported abuse and provided photos of previous injuries as well as injuries sustained during this incident. Their 2-year-old son was present inside the home at the time. Smith was arrested and transported to the Shreveport City Jail for:

Arrest of Jennifer Hamilton

On October 30, 2025, officers arrested Jennifer Hamilton for the following offenses:

Arrest of Cavisia Goode

Also stemming from an October 30, 2025 incident, officers arrested Cavisia Goode for:

- (1) count Domestic Abuse Battery by Strangulation
 - (3) counts Domestic Abuse Battery With Child Endangerment
 - (1) count Violation of a Protection Order

Arrest of Antonio White

Detectives with the Domestic Violence Unit arrested Antonio White following a traffic stop. White had active warrants for:

- (1) count Domestic Abuse Battery by Strangulation
- (1) count Domestic Abuse Battery

He was also charged with Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) and additional traffic violations.
