## Arrests and Warrants Issued Following April Vehicle Burglaries and Shooting



### Kameron Manning & Jamicheal Pennington

On Saturday, April 5, 2025, at approximately 3:30 a.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to the 7600 block of University Drive regarding reports of shots fired.

The 911 caller reported that two masked individuals were breaking into vehicles along the street and had stolen a vehicle from one of the residences. While the victim was on the phone with emergency dispatchers, one of the suspects noticed him and began approaching. Fearing for the safety of himself and his family, the victim discharged his firearm twice, striking one of the suspects—18-year-old Jamelvion “JoJo” Lewis—in the upper body.

Officers arrived on scene and immediately began rendering aid. During their response, officers discovered Lewis was armed with a firearm that had been previously reported stolen in Bossier City.

The second suspect fled in the stolen vehicle but abandoned it a short distance away before escaping on foot. Through continued investigation, detectives determined that Lewis and another individual burglarized multiple vehicles along the 7600 block of University Drive in the early morning hours of April 5th.

Further investigative efforts led detectives to identify Kameron Manning (04/14/2004) and Jamicheal “T da Menace” Pennington (06/06/2006) as accomplices in the series of burglaries.

On Friday, November 14, 2025, the Honorable Judge Emanuel signed and approved the following warrants, each with No Bond:

For Kameron Manning:

- Warrant #3194 – 1 count Simple Burglary (14:62)

- Warrant #3195 – 1 count Simple Burglary (14:62)
- Warrant #3196 – 1 count Theft of Motor Vehicle (14:67.26)
- Warrant #3197 – 1 count Simple Burglary (14:62) and 1 count Theft of Firearm (14:67.15)

For Jamicheal Pennington:

- Warrant #3198 – 1 count Principal to Simple Burglary (14:62)
- Warrant #3199 – 1 count Principal to Simple Burglary (14:62)
- Warrant #3200 – 1 count Principal to Theft of Motor Vehicle (14:67.26)
- Warrant #3201 – 1 count Principal to Simple Burglary (14:62) and Principal to Theft of Firearm (14:67.15)

Pennington is currently incarcerated at Bossier Parish Maximum Security Facility on multiple charges and was already awaiting extradition to Shreveport for an unrelated charge of Attempted Second-Degree Murder.
