City Announces Short-Term Lane Closures on Kings Highway for Safety Improvements

The City of Shreveport is issuing this public notice to inform motorists of a series of temporary lane closures that will take place on Kings Highway between Interstate 20 and Interstate 49. These closures will occur from *December 8 through December 12, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. each day*. At no point will the roadway be fully closed; instead, only one travel lane will be closed at any given time to ensure that traffic can continue to move through the area.

The purpose of these temporary lane closures is to provide a safe work zone for personnel performing drainage structure work within the travel lanes. This activity requires workers and equipment to be positioned close to moving traffic, and the controlled lane closures are necessary to protect both the work crews and the traveling public.

During the closure periods, motorists traveling on Kings Highway are urged to use caution when approaching and driving through the construction zone. Drivers should reduce speed, remain attentive, follow all posted signs and instructions from flaggers, and avoid all distractions. Motorists are reminded that construction zones can present unexpected conditions, such as lane shifts, workers near the roadway, or slow-moving equipment. Allowing extra time for travel or seeking an alternate route is encouraged.
