## Arrest Made Following Armed Assault on Hardy Street

On November 21, 2025, at approximately 10:45 p.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to a report of an armed person near the intersection of Hardy Street and Kentucky Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers made contact with the involved parties and identified the suspect as Erica Clay, a Black female, at a residence in the 2800 block of Hardy Street.

The victim reported that he had been assisting Clay with putting up a Christmas tree earlier that evening. According to the victim, a verbal dispute occurred after he asked to be compensated for his help. He stated he left the residence following the argument, but Clay allegedly followed him down the road and threatened him with a firearm.

Following the investigation, Erica Clay was charged with one count of Aggravated Assault with a Firearm.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to thoroughly investigating all incidents involving weapons and ensuring the safety of our community.
