Seatbelt Checkpoint – Shreveport Police Department

The Shreveport Police Department, in partnership with the Louisiana Highway Safety Commission, will conduct a Seatbelt Checkpoint on December 10, 2025, beginning at 12:00 p.m. and concluding at 5:00 p.m. in the southeastern area of the city.

This checkpoint is designed to identify drivers and occupants who are not in compliance with Louisiana's occupant protection laws. While the primary focus will be seatbelt violations, the checkpoint will not be limited solely to those offenses. Officers will be actively engaged in efforts to reduce the number of fatalities and serious injuries resulting from crashes involving unrestrained motorists.

The checkpoint will be constructed and conducted in accordance with the Louisiana State Police Roadside Safety Checkpoint Manual to ensure safety and compliance with established operational guidelines.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to protecting our community through proactive traffic enforcement and public safety initiatives.
