Major Head-On Collision

On December 3, 2025, at approximately 1806 hours, the Shreveport Police Department responded to a major crash at West 70th Street and Meriwether Road. Upon arrival, officers discovered that a blue 2007 Nissan Altima and a red 2002 Chevy Tahoe had collided head-on.

The driver of the blue Nissan Altima sustained severe head injuries and was found unconscious and not breathing. He was transported to Ochsner LSU Health with life-threatening injuries. The driver of the red Chevy Tahoe was also transported to Ochsner LSU Health with initially non-life-threatening injuries, but her condition was later upgraded to life-threatening.

The Shreveport Police Department Crash Investigations Unit responded to the scene. Preliminary findings indicate that the Nissan Altima was traveling westbound on West 70th Street. As the driver entered the curve approaching Meriwether Road, he crossed over the double yellow line for unknown reasons and struck the Chevy Tahoe head-on. The Tahoe was traveling eastbound at the time of the crash.

While in the emergency room, medical personnel observed signs that the driver of the Nissan Altima may have experienced a medical episode related to blood sugar levels.

On December 4, 2025, the Shreveport Police Department was contacted by the Caddo Parish Coroner's Office and notified of the unfortunate passing of the driver of the blue 2007 Nissan Altima.
