Shreveport Police Arrest Man for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender

Shreveport Police Department Sex Crimes Detectives have arrested Ellis Kitchen on one count of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender.

Kitchen was previously convicted of Attempted Forcible Rape and, as a result of that conviction, is required by law to register as a sex offender for life. Following an investigation, detectives obtained an arrest warrant, and Kitchen was taken into custody today by members of the Shreveport Police Department Sex Crimes Unit.

Investigators also confirmed that Kitchen has two prior convictions for failure to register as a sex offender.

The Shreveport Police Department takes violations of sex offender registration laws very seriously, as these requirements are critical tools used to protect victims and the community at large.

The department would like to commend and thank our Sex Crimes Detectives for their continued diligence and commitment to holding offenders accountable and protecting vulnerable members of our community.
