Shreveport Police Arrest Man Following Trespassing Incident on Pines Road

Shreveport Police have arrested Timothy Williams following an incident in the 6700 block of Pines Road.

On the day of the incident, officers were dispatched to the location in reference to a trespassing complaint. The caller requested that Williams be removed from the property due to prior incidents involving obscene behavior at that location.

Upon arrival, officers contacted Williams and took him into custody. During the investigation, officers determined that Williams had an outstanding warrant for trespassing.

As officers attempted to place Williams under arrest, he resisted their efforts. Williams was ultimately taken into custody without further incident.

- Trespassing
- Obscenity
- Littering
- Resisting an Officer
- Trespassing (Outstanding Warrant)
