Shreveport Police Arrest Suspect in Retail Theft; Second Suspect Outstanding

The Shreveport Police Department has made an arrest following a retail theft investigation at Citi Trends.

On December 2, 2025, at approximately 5:52 p.m., officers responded to a reported theft at Citi Trends, located at 6713 Pines Road. Employees reported that a Black female and a Black male—identified as Michelle Collins and Alonzo Collins—were stealing merchandise from the store.

Detectives reviewed surveillance footage, which corroborated the employees' statements. The video shows the suspects collecting clothing from throughout the store, bypassing all points of sale, and exiting the business without paying. When an employee attempted to recover the merchandise from Michelle Collins at the door, Alonzo Collins approached and took possession of the clothing. Both suspects then fled the scene in a black, Cadillac-style sedan.

A witness advised detectives that she knew the suspects and positively identified both individuals.

Further investigation revealed that Michelle Collins already had an active arrest warrant related to a separate theft that occurred at the Mansfield Road Citi Trends on June 28, 2025. On December 23, 2025, patrol officers executed that warrant at her residence. Michelle Collins was taken into custody without incident and transported to the Shreveport City Jail.

Alonzo Collins remains outstanding at this time.
