2026 Begins with Arrests of Armed Convicted Felons

The start of 2026 has already seen Shreveport Police officers removing illegal firearms from the streets.

On January 1, officers conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of East 77th Street and Henderson Avenue. During the investigation, officers located narcotics and multiple firearms inside the vehicle.

As a result of the investigation, Jaylen Cox and Demon Dixon were arrested after both were found to be in possession of firearms while legally prohibited from doing so due to prior felony convictions.

Cox now faces charges for narcotics possession and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. Cox has prior convictions from 2019 involving weapons and narcotics and was also out on bond at the time of this arrest for an aggravated flight charge.

Dixon was also determined to be a convicted felon, with prior firearm-related convictions dating back to 2011 and 2019.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to aggressively targeting armed offenders and removing illegal weapons from the community to keep residents safe.
