Shreveport Police VCAT Take MORE GUNS Off the Streets

On January 12, 2026, at approximately 11:30 a.m., members of the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Abatement Team (VCAT) responded to multiple complaints of individuals reportedly in possession of firearms at the Stone Vista Apartments, located at 541 E. Stoner Avenue.

While conducting surveillance in the area, VCAT members observed two individuals who appeared to be in possession of firearms. Due to the nature of the complaints, assistance was requested from the Shreveport City Marshal's Office and the Shreveport Police Department Warrants Unit.

Once additional units arrived, the two individuals were observed leaving the apartment complex and walking along Easy Street. Officers attempted to make contact with the subjects, at which point both individuals fled on foot.

One subject, identified as **Quintravius Winbush** (DOB: 07/16/1999), was apprehended after a brief foot pursuit. Winbush was found to be in possession of a loaded firearm and marijuana. The second individual was observed discarding a .233 caliber semi-automatic pistol during the pursuit but was not apprehended. That firearm was recovered by officers.

Winbush was transported to the Shreveport City Jail and charged with the following offenses:

- Possession of Marijuana Greater Than 14 Grams
- Resisting an Officer
- Illegal Carrying of a Weapon with Controlled Dangerous Substances

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to proactively addressing illegal firearms activity and responding swiftly to community concerns to help ensure public safety.
