Suspect Wanted in Attempted Armed Robbery and Theft Investigation



Corey D. Clark

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department are seeking the arrest of Corey D. Clark (DOB: 10/04/1983) in connection with an attempted armed robbery and felony theft.

Charges:

- Count 1: RS 14:27.64 – Attempted Armed Robbery (Felony)
- Count 1: RS 14:67(B)(3) – Theft Between \$750 and \$5,000 (Felony)

On December 24, 2025, at approximately 7:20 p.m., officers responded to a reported armed robbery at a residence in the 7000 block of Fern Avenue. The victim reported that Clark—whom he had previously met through the dating application Grindr—came to his residence and was allowed inside.

Once inside, Clark allegedly produced a black-and-silver handgun, pointed it at the victim, and demanded large sums of money while making threats to shoot and kill him. Clark further attempted to intimidate the victim by claiming that additional suspects were waiting outside.

As the two exited the residence, Clark allegedly took the victim's cellular phone without permission and fled the scene in a vehicle. During the course of the investigation, detectives confirmed prior incidents in which Clark had unlawfully taken money, identification, and credit cards from the same victim.

Arrest warrants have been issued for Corey D. Clark. Anyone with information regarding his whereabouts is urged to contact the Shreveport Police Department or Caddo Crime Stoppers. Tips may be submitted anonymously.
