Shreveport Police Arrest Suspect in Catalytic Converter Theft Investigation

On January 2, 2026, the Shreveport Police Department Property Crimes Unit began an investigation into the theft of multiple catalytic converters from a business located in the 500 block of Aero Drive.

On January 14, 2026, detectives conducted a follow-up investigation in the 500 block of Calhoun Street. At that location, investigators located two vehicles believed to have been used in the thefts parked on a vacant lot: a silver Chevrolet HHR and a gold GMC Yukon.

The Chevrolet HHR was occupied by a Black male and a Black female at the time detectives arrived. The GMC Yukon was unoccupied. Through video surveillance, detectives identified Jericko Miller (Black male, DOB: 11/26/1981) as a suspect in the thefts. Miller was observed on surveillance footage shortly after attempting to remove another catalytic converter and was seated in the driver's seat of the Chevrolet HHR.

During the investigation, detectives located multiple reciprocating saws, saw blades, and a floor jack. While conducting an inventory of the vehicles prior to towing, officers discovered additional tools commonly used in catalytic converter thefts. Six stolen catalytic converters were recovered from the GMC Yukon.

Jericko Miller was transported to the Shreveport City Jail and will be transferred to the Caddo Correctional Center. He has been charged with twelve counts of theft of catalytic converters.

The investigation remains ongoing.
