Shreveport Police Arrest Three in Burglary at Former Shreveport Country Club

Just after noon on January 15, Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to a reported burglary in progress at 3101 Esplanade Avenue, the former Shreveport Country Club.

Officers made contact with the property manager, who advised that a chain and lock securing the property had been cut. The manager indicated the damage appeared recent, as the lock had just been replaced.

Shreveport Police K-9 units were requested, and a search of the property was conducted. During the search, K-9 Edy and his handler located two female suspects, Hillary Morrow and Kristina Ivey, hiding on the property. Officers determined the suspects were attempting to steal copper from the premises.

Ivey sustained injuries during her apprehension by the K-9 and was treated for those injuries. Further investigation revealed that both Morrow and Ivey had outstanding warrants. Additionally, Morrow was found to be armed with a handgun at the time of her arrest.

As the investigation continued, officers located a third suspect, David Harmon, also on the property.

Charges:

Kristina Ivey and David Harmon: Simple Burglary

Hillary Morrow: Aggravated Burglary

Both Morrow and Ivey were also booked on their outstanding warrants.

This investigation remains ongoing.
