Shreveport Police Investigating Felony Property Damage – Suspects Wanted

The Shreveport Police Department is investigating a case of extensive felony property damage reported on December 17, 2025, involving a rental residence located in the 3500 block of East 68th Street.

The complainant reported that her former tenants, Quantreven Martin and Shakira Kennedy, intentionally caused significant damage throughout the residence prior to moving out. According to the victim, she had advised the couple they would be evicted after failing to pay rent for two months. She believes the damage was inflicted in retaliation.

During the investigation, detectives reviewed photographic evidence showing damage well beyond normal wear and tear, including:

Numerous holes in multiple walls

Interior doors ripped off their hinges.

Iron burn marks on carpet in several rooms.

Broken windows

Damaged furniture and fixtures

Both individuals were scheduled for interviews with detectives but failed to appear. As a result, Quantreven Martin and Shakira Kennedy are now wanted in connection with this property damage investigation.

Additionally, Quantreven Martin is confirmed to have an active warrant related to a domestic violence offense.
