**City of Shreveport Offices Closed Monday Due to Winter Weather;
Possible Closure Tuesday**

Due to the ongoing winter weather and hazardous road conditions caused by the ice storm, all City of Shreveport offices will be closed on Monday to ensure the safety of employees and the public.

City officials will continue to closely monitor weather and road conditions. Depending on conditions, City offices may also remain closed on Tuesday. An update regarding Tuesday operations will be communicated as soon as possible.

Essential public safety and emergency services will continue to operate as normal, including police, fire, and emergency response.

Garbage collection scheduled for Monday will not take place. The City will continue to evaluate conditions and will provide updates on revised garbage collection schedules as soon as it is safe to resume service.

Residents are urged to limit travel unless absolutely necessary and to take appropriate precautions during freezing conditions. The City is coordinating with local and state partners to respond to the storm and address impacts as conditions allow.

The City reminds residents to:

- Avoid icy roads and bridges, which may freeze before other surfaces
- Check on elderly neighbors and those without adequate heat
- Use space heaters safely and never leave them unattended
- Follow updates from local emergency management and utility providers
