MORE CHARGES



Quantreven “Tay Tay” Martin & Jaricko “Rico” Miller

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department Property Crimes Unit continue to make progress in their ongoing investigation into catalytic converter thefts throughout the city.

As a result of continued investigative efforts, detectives identified two suspects and obtained **additional charges** related to multiple theft incidents. Both individuals were previously incarcerated on similar offenses, and these new charges further expand the scope of the investigation.

The following individuals were identified and charged with **three additional counts of Theft of a Catalytic Converter**, bringing their total charges to:

- **Quantreven “Tay Tay” Martin** (Black male, DOB: 02/05/2003) – now facing **four total counts** of Theft of a Catalytic Converter
- **Jaricko “Rico” Miller** (Black male, DOB: 11/26/1981) – now facing **fifteen total counts** of Theft of a Catalytic Converter

Both Martin and Miller are currently incarcerated at the **Caddo Correctional Center** on other catalytic converter theft charges.

The Shreveport Police Department continues to aggressively investigate catalytic converter thefts and reminds residents to report suspicious activity immediately. Anyone with information related to these crimes is encouraged to contact Shreveport Police or Caddo Crime Stoppers.
