Shreveport Police Investigate Assault at Local Hospital

On January 26, at approximately 1:30 p.m., officers with the Shreveport Police Department responded to reports of an assault and battery at a local hospital.

Upon arrival, officers learned that Christian Henderson was involved in a disturbance inside the facility. Henderson reportedly attempted to follow a female nurse into a restricted area. When hospital personnel asked him to stop, Henderson became irate and physically attacked staff members.

During the incident, Henderson was observed swinging wildly at hospital personnel as staff attempted to de-escalate the situation. He also bit a hospital employee, breaking the skin. Hospital staff sustained injuries to the head and forearm and were treated for their injuries.

Henderson was taken into custody and now faces multiple charges, including Battery of Emergency Room Personnel, Second Degree Battery, and Battery of a Police Officer. Further investigation revealed Henderson also had an active warrant for Simple Battery.

The Shreveport Police Department takes assaults on medical professionals extremely seriously, and such behavior will not be tolerated. Our hospital staff work tirelessly to care for this community, and violence against them is unacceptable.
