Domestic Violence Ruins Lives

The Shreveport Police Department continues its ongoing efforts to combat domestic violence within our community.

Over the past several days, officers have made multiple arrests related to incidents involving violence against household members:

- January 29, 2026: Christopher Moran was arrested and charged with one count of *Domestic Abuse Battery with Serious Bodily Injury* and one count of *Domestic Abuse Battery, Second Degree*.
- January 28, 2026: Hunter George was arrested and charged with two counts of *Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment*, one count of *Battery of a Dating Partner with Strangulation*, and one count of *Simple Battery*.
- January 27, 2026: Derek Smith was arrested and charged with three counts of *Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment*.

Each of these incidents involved acts of violence against household or family members.

Domestic violence is a cancer in our community—one that destroys families, traumatizes children, and ruins lives. The Shreveport Police Department is increasingly seeing these incidents involve younger individuals, underscoring the urgent need for education, communication, and early intervention.

If you find yourself in a domestic situation that is escalating or turning physical, we urge you to remove yourself from the situation and seek help before it is too late. Resources are available, and no one deserves to be a victim of abuse.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to holding offenders accountable and working alongside community partners to prevent domestic violence and protect those most vulnerable.
