Felony Theft Arrest Made in Casino Parking Garage Theft

On November 20, 2025, patrol officers with the Shreveport Police Department were dispatched to the 1700 block of Audrey Lane in reference to a reported theft that occurred at 315 Clyde Fant Parkway, the Sam's Town Casino and Hotel.

Upon arrival, officers made contact with the complainant, who advised that he arrived at Sam's Town Casino on November 19, 2025, at approximately 9:40 p.m. The victim stated he parked his vehicle, which had an attached trailer, inside the casino's parking garage. Secured to the trailer was a Honda generator.

When the victim returned to his vehicle on November 20, 2025, he discovered the generator had been stolen.

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department contacted Sam's Town Casino and Hotel security personnel and obtained surveillance footage of the incident. The video shows a male, later identified as **Colton Walker**, arriving in a Ford Maverick and parking next to the victim's vehicle and trailer. Walker is observed exiting the vehicle, removing the generator from the trailer, loading it into the bed of the truck, and leaving the area.

On January 29, 2026, detectives arrested Colton Walker at the Caddo Correctional Center, where he was already incarcerated on unrelated charges. Walker now faces an additional **felony theft** charge related to this investigation.

The Shreveport Police Department reminds the public to report suspicious activity and continues working closely with local businesses to hold offenders accountable.
