## Shreveport Police Seek Suspect in Multiple Felony Thefts

The Shreveport Police Department's Property Crimes Unit is investigating multiple felony thefts involving a repeat offender and is asking for the public's help in locating the suspect.

On January 21, 2026, at approximately 1:45 p.m., officers responded to a reported theft at Home Depot, 6900 Pines Road. Detectives determined the suspect to be Jason Langley, a white male who is also linked to a theft that occurred the previous day.

During the earlier incident on January 20, 2026, Langley allegedly committed a theft valued at approximately \$2,000 at the Home Depot located at 110 E. Bert Kouns Industrial Loop. After that theft, Langley fled the scene in a 2005 black Acura.

When Langley attempted another theft on January 21 at the Pines Road location, asset protection personnel closely followed him. Langley ran to the same black Acura but was unable to enter the vehicle and fled the area on foot, eastbound from the store, abandoning the locked vehicle in the parking lot.

Upon arrival, detectives observed—through the vehicle windows—multiple unopened DeWalt and Milwaukee power-tool batteries and new Milwaukee tool bags in the rear cargo area. The vehicle was impounded to central storage and later searched pursuant to a warrant.

Further investigation and surveillance footage from the January 20 incident show Langley arriving at the Bert Kouns location at approximately 7:40 p.m. Video captures Langley cutting the lock off a secured cage containing power-tool batteries, selecting items, concealing them in his waistband, and exiting the store without payment.

Langley is a known subject at the business. Detectives say his modus operandi involves stealing power tools and batteries. He has an extensive criminal history related to theft and shoplifting and currently has an active felony theft warrant. Langley is now wanted in connection with multiple additional thefts in the area.
