Another Armed Felon Arrested

On February 3, 2026, at approximately 9:30 a.m., multiple law-enforcement agencies came together in a coordinated effort to take a wanted fugitive off the streets of Shreveport.

The Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit, VCAT, and Warrant's Unit, alongside the Shreveport City Marshal's Office and Louisiana State Probation & Parole, developed and executed a plan to serve search and arrest warrants at a residence in the 1700 block of Clanton Street.

Upon arrival, officers safely took **Martin Davenport** into custody without incident. A subsequent search of the residence led to the recovery of a firearm. Further investigation revealed Davenport is a multiple-time convicted felon with prior convictions including aggravated burglary and aggravated second-degree battery. As a result of this operation, he has now been charged with:

- Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon
- Resisting an Officer
- Fugitive Warrants (Illegal Appropriation & Parole Violation)

Davenport was transported to the Shreveport City Jail where he was booked and the recovered evidence was submitted.

This arrest highlights the continued commitment and partnership between local and state agencies to target violent offenders and keep illegal firearms out of the hands of convicted felons.

The Shreveport Police Department will continue to work aggressively to hold repeat offenders accountable and keep our community safe.
