Shreveport Police Continue Strong Efforts to Combat Domestic Violence

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to protecting victims and holding offenders accountable as we continue working to combat domestic violence in our community. Over the weekend, officers made several arrests related to domestic violence incidents, reinforcing our ongoing effort to shine a light on an issue that impacts families across our city.

Arrests:

- **February 15, just after 10:00 AM** – *Lisa Fischer* was arrested for **Domestic Abuse Battery** and **Domestic Abuse Child Endangerment**.
- **February 13, just after 2:00 PM** – *Chasmine Hamilton* was arrested for **Domestic Abuse Child Endangerment** and **Domestic Abuse Battery with a Dangerous Weapon**.
- **February 15, just after 3:30 AM** – *Breion Jones* was arrested for **Illegal Possession of Stolen Things, Resisting an Officer**, and was also found to be wanted for **Domestic Abuse Battery**.
- **February 14, just before 6:00 PM** – *Michael Ruffins* was arrested for **Domestic Abuse Battery by Strangulation**.

All of these offenses are considered crimes of violence involving household or former household members. Domestic violence situations are serious, dangerous, and often escalate if left unaddressed.

Many of these incidents can be prevented through healthy conflict resolution, early intervention, and by ensuring victims have access to support services. The Shreveport Police Department strongly encourages anyone experiencing domestic violence to seek help. You are not alone, and resources are available.
