Shreveport Police to Conduct Sobriety Checkpoint in East Shreveport

The Shreveport Police Department's Field Support Bureau will conduct a sobriety checkpoint in East Shreveport on Friday, February 27, 2026, beginning at 10:00 p.m. (2200 hours). The operation will conclude in the early morning hours of Saturday, February 28, 2026.

This checkpoint will be conducted in accordance with Louisiana Highway Safety Commission (LHSC) guidelines to ensure the safety and constitutional rights of all motorists.

Officers will be specifically focused on identifying and removing impaired drivers from our roadways. However, enforcement efforts will not be limited strictly to impaired driving offenses. Officers will also be observing for other violations of state and local laws to help ensure the overall safety of our community.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to reducing impaired driving and preventing needless tragedies caused by unsafe and impaired motorists.

We encourage all drivers to make responsible choices. If you plan to consume alcohol, please designate a sober driver, use a rideshare service, or make other safe transportation arrangements.
