Shreveport Police Partner with Louisiana ICAC Task Force in Child Exploitation Operation

The Shreveport Police Department is proud to partner with the Louisiana Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force in the ongoing fight to protect children from online exploitation.

Members of the Shreveport Police Department Vice Unit assigned to the task force have been working alongside the Louisiana Attorney General's Office and the Louisiana Bureau of Investigation to conduct proactive investigations targeting individuals who exploit children for the purposes of human trafficking and sexual abuse.

As a result of a recent operation, Shreveport Police arrested **David Clark**. On February 27, 2026, Clark was charged with:

- Indecent Behavior with Juveniles
- Computer-Aided Solicitation of a Minor

Clark is accused of attempting to engage in a sexual relationship with a 15-year-old boy during the course of the investigation.

The Shreveport Police Department, in coordination with the ICAC Task Force and its state and federal partners, will continue to investigate, arrest, and aggressively pursue prosecution of online predators who target children.

We also remain committed to educating families about online safety. Parents and guardians are encouraged to actively monitor their children's internet activity, maintain open communication about online interactions, and report suspicious behavior to law enforcement immediately.

Protecting our children is not optional — it is our priority.
