## **City of Shreveport to Distribute Free Bottled Water to Residents**

In response to ongoing system impacts from the recent transmission main break and the citywide voluntary boil advisory, the City of Shreveport is actively working to bring in bottled water from across the region and distribute it to residents as shipments arrive.

Because deliveries are coming in at different times, water distribution sites will be announced as product is received and ready for pickup.

If water becomes available at additional locations, the public will be notified through official City communication channels.

Water is available **while supplies last**, and residents are encouraged to remain in their vehicles and follow on-site directions to ensure a safe and efficient distribution process.

The City appreciates the community's patience and cooperation as crews continue working around the clock to stabilize the water system. Updates regarding the boil advisory and repair efforts will continue to be shared through official channels.
