

Domestic Violence Cases



The Shreveport Police Department continues its proactive enforcement efforts in combating the epidemic of domestic violence in our community. Over the past several days, officers have made multiple arrests tied to domestic-related offenses.

On March 2nd, just before 2:30 PM, Leroderick Bell was arrested for one count of Simple Battery of a Dating Partner.

On February 27th at approximately 6:00 AM, officers arrested Ricky Hampton on multiple charges, including:

- Two counts of Domestic Abuse Battery
- One count of Improper Telephone Communications
- One count of Simple Battery

Hampton was also determined to be a fugitive from the Shelby County Sheriff's Office.

On February 26th around 1:00 PM, Jennifer Huglon was arrested for:

- One count of Domestic Abuse Battery
- One count of Domestic Abuse Battery – Child Endangerment

On February 20th at approximately 1:45 PM, Angela Williams was arrested for one count of Simple Battery of a Dating Partner in connection with a previously reported case.

On February 28th just after midnight, Anthony Young was arrested for:

- One count of Violation of a Restraining Order
- One count of Domestic Abuse Battery

The Shreveport Police Department continues to see domestic violence offenses occurring throughout our city. These crimes are especially troubling when committed in the presence of children. Domestic violence not only harms victims physically but leaves lasting emotional trauma on families and young witnesses.

If you or someone you know is experiencing domestic violence, we encourage you to seek help. Our officers will continue to investigate, arrest, and work with our prosecutorial partners to hold offenders accountable.

Domestic violence has no place in our community — and we will not stop fighting it.
