Shreveport Police Investigate Fatal Pedestrian Crash on Youree Drive

On Thursday, March 6, at approximately 8:34 p.m., officers with the Shreveport Police Department responded to a major crash involving a vehicle and a pedestrian at the intersection of E. Dalzell Street and Youree Drive.

Upon arrival, officers found members of the Shreveport Fire Department already on scene rendering medical aid to the pedestrian. The victim was transported to a local hospital but unfortunately succumbed to injuries sustained in the crash.

Preliminary investigation indicates a vehicle traveling southbound on Youree Drive struck the pedestrian while he was in the roadway. Following the initial impact, a second vehicle traveling in the same direction also struck the pedestrian, who was lying in the roadway.

Crime Scene Investigators were called to the scene to assist in confirming the identity of the victim. The department's DWI Unit also responded, and both drivers voluntarily provided blood samples as part of the investigation.

The deceased individual was later released to the Caddo Parish Coroner's Office.

At this time, no wrongdoing is suspected by either driver, and the investigation remains ongoing.

The Shreveport Police Department would like to remind the public that pedestrian safety remains a growing concern on our roadways. Pedestrians are strongly encouraged to use designated crosswalks and remain alert when crossing busy streets. Likewise, drivers should remain vigilant for pedestrians, especially along heavily traveled corridors such as Youree Drive.
