## AMENDMENT #1

### RFP 26-803

## THREE (3) ON DEMAND PAVEMENT RESTORATION CONTRACTS

Proposers on the Project are hereby notified that this Amendment shall be attached to and made part of the above-named solicitation documents dated **March 17, 2026**. The following items are issued to add to, to modify, and/or clarify the solicitation documents. These items shall have full force and effect as the solicitation documents. Proposals to be submitted on the specified bid date shall conform to the additions and revisions listed herein. Acknowledge receipt of all amendments received by inserting the total number received on signature page of the bid form. Failure to do so may subject the bid to being declared as non-responsive.

**It shall be the Bidder's responsibility to make an inquiry as to any Amendments issued.**

### QUESTIONS

1.0 Is a bid bond required for this RFP?

**No bid bond is required.**

2.0 Curb and Gutter item numbers -5 curb and gutter – Can the description of these be changed to curbing only; not curb and gutter?

**No, the City prefers to use current items 3-5 curb and gutter.**

4.0 Is it W&S responsibility to have the job at subgrade before the contractor gets to the site? Understanding that subgrade means that the job will be close to specifications? (example 6-inch street will be dug out with equipment to the nearest depth)

**The City should backfill to top of desired subgrade once W&S repairs are complete. If this is not the case, the Contractor is allowed to request payment for additional fill using item S-1 Miscellaneous Items. Note: Before pavement restoration work can begin, Contractor must have City's prior approval for any reimbursement of additional fill for subgrade work.**

5.0 I understand that final clean up includes stakes, forms, wash out and any material produced by the contractor. Who is responsible for removing any of the original material asphalt, concrete, rock, etc. from the original site? The reason for this question is at previous job location there was excessive amounts of concrete, dirt, rock etc. that my company had to bring out dump trucks and excavators to pick up the material at no additional cost.

**See page 10 of 39, 8.21.3 of the RFP: This means the City is responsible for removing all original pavement and excavation material removed due to repair of water and sewer lines. The Pavement Restoration Contractor is responsible for all sawcut and removal of existing pavement and miscellaneous material necessary for new pavement work.**

6.0 Will contractors be required to provide heavy equipment at the job locations? If so, how will contractors be compensated for this expense?

**Contractor is required to provide all equipment for removing original pavement due to Contractor's sawcut work including broken concrete, asphalt, dirt, rock, etc. This work is included in the fixed unit prices provided and there will be no additional compensation.**

7.0 Page 13 Narrative on the approach to the scope of work. Proposals should respond to the Scope of Work point by point by numerical reference. Does point by point require bidder to list and acknowledge every

point as most points are non-responsive statements. Ex: 1.5 Contractor will only be allowed to qualify for only one of the multiple contracts to be awarded. How would bidder acknowledge this point?

**Submittal of Exhibit A is NOT required for this RFP.**

8.0 Page 14 Schedule of Events. This is an on-demand contract. Generally, there are no predetermined sizes of jobs being issued, which means that a contractor will only have knowledge of time of completion based on the size of the job? Does Schedule of Events apply to an on-demand project. If so can you please provide an example of how it may be required?


