Shreveport Police Seek Suspect in Attempted Second-Degree Homicide

On March 9, 2026, officers with the Shreveport Police Department responded to Ochsner LSU Health, located at 1501 Kings Highway, after a male victim arrived at the hospital suffering from a stab wound to the back.

The victim was transported to the hospital in a personal vehicle. Upon arrival, responding officers made contact with him and were able to gather preliminary information about the incident, including the location where it occurred and the identity of a possible suspect.

Through the investigation, the suspect was identified as Nicholas D. Parks, who is believed to have fled the scene shortly after the stabbing.

On March 10, 2026, an arrest warrant was signed for Nicholas D. Parks for Attempted Second-Degree Homicide.

The Shreveport Police Department is asking for the public's help in locating Parks. Anyone with information on his whereabouts is urged to contact the Shreveport Police Department or Caddo Crime Stoppers.
