Felon Arrested After Domestic Disturbance Leads to Discovery of Stolen Firearm



On March 11, 2026, at approximately 7:06 PM, officers with the Shreveport Police Department were dispatched to the **3700 block of Beckham Street** in reference to a vandalism complaint involving a domestic disturbance.

Upon arrival, officers made contact with the complainant, who reported that her boyfriend had begun damaging the walls inside their apartment, causing her to fear for her safety.

The complainant further advised officers that the suspect, **Latrenton Babers (B/M, DOB: 03/28/2003)**, had a firearm concealed near his side of the bed. Officers were also informed that Babers had a prior conviction for **Illegal Use of Weapons** on May 23, 2022, making it unlawful for him to possess a firearm.

During the investigation, officers located and seized a **Smith & Wesson handgun** from the bedroom. Babers was taken into custody and transported to the Shreveport City Jail.

Further investigation revealed that the firearm had been **reported stolen in May of 2025**.

Babers has been charged with:

- **Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon**
- **Possession of a Stolen Firearm**

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to responding swiftly to domestic disturbances and removing illegal firearms from our community.
