Arrest warrants obtained in weekend shooting

Two men with alleged involvement in a weekend shooting which sent eight people to the hospital are now being sought by authorities.

Antonio Rhines 20, along with 19 year old Treveon Wilson, have been identified as two of the alleged shooters in the July 5th shooting that occurred in the 3500 block of Hearne Avenue. The pair was developed as suspects in the matter during the inquiry which remains underway by Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives.

During their probe of the incident, authorities determined they had previously arrested Rhines back in August of 2012, then charging him with illegal use of a weapon and attempted second degree murder after evidence revealed he fired a gun multiple times while at a crowded service station in the 3700 block of Hearne Avenue. During that incident, a female victim was subsequently struck in the back by a stray round. Rhines, now a convicted felon, once again faces charges of illegal use of a weapon, with the added charge of convicted felon in possession of a firearm. His bond has been set a \$200,000.00. Wilson, of the 1500 block of Harvard Avenue in Shreveport, also faces a charge of illegal use of a weapon for his alleged involvement in the crime. His bond has been set at \$50,000.00.
