Early morning shooting ends tragically

Shreveport Police investigators have made public the identity of a local man slain early Monday morning in the 1500 block of Clover Street in west Shreveport.

Anthony Washington, 44, of the 1500 block of Clover Street, was shot and killed Monday morning by an assailant who remains at large. Just after 5:30 a.m. Shreveport Police patrol officers were called to a "shots fired" call in the 1500 block of Clover Street, where numerous reports of gunshots were received. As officers arrived at the scene, they soon discovered the body of Washington, who was suffering a gunshot wound to the upper body. Washington was declared deceased on scene by emergency medical personnel from the Shreveport Fire Department.

Violent Crimes detectives were called to the scene, initiating an immediate investigation into the deadly shooting. Preliminary information gathered at the scene suggests an argument between Washington and another man ensued, ending in a hail of gunshots being fired. Evidence of the crime was seized and processed by members of the Shreveport Police Department's Crime Scene Investigations Unit. At current there are no suspects in police custody; however authorities are working feverishly following up on leads and to determine the identity and apprehend the person responsible for the crime.
