Two Charged in slaying of local man

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives have now charged two local residents in connection with an ongoing murder investigation into the city's most recent homicide.

Just after 2:00 p.m., authorities booked 28 year old Amanda B. Williams and 27 year old Cameron Lewis into the Shreveport City Jail after evidence of their involvement in the murder of 55 year old Bryan Savage was established. The pair of suspects were originally detained by police just before 6:00 a.m. Tuesday morning after they were located inside a hotel in the 5200 block of Monkhouse Drive in west Shreveport. Patrolmen working in the area near the hotel, initially spotted a white Chevrolet Avalanche, fitting the description of one sought in the homicide investigation, parked in the hotel's parking lot. The discovery of the truck led to a several hour long operation which ultimately ended peacefully with the detaining of three subjects to include Williams and Lewis.

Authorities, upon transporting Lewis, Williams and a third person to Shreveport Police headquarters, launched an interrogation revealing details relevant to the crime. Following subsequent interviews with detectives, Lewis and Williams were arrested and now each face a charge of Principal to First Degree Murder. Additionally, Williams was booked on Aggravated Burglary charges after evidence of her involvement in a previous burglary of Savage's home earlier this year was uncovered. While the arrest of Williams and Lewis represent early successes in the homicide investigation, investigators expect even more details to emerge as the inquiry moves forward.
