Early morning shooting leaves local man injured

Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives are seeking information regarding a shooting which left a local man suffering multiple gunshot wounds and a suspect at large Tuesday morning.

Just before 3:00 a.m. on February 23, 2016, Shreveport Police patrol officers were dispatched to Willis-Knighon Medical Center's North location relative to an adult male victim who arrived at the facilities emergency room suffering multiple gunshot wounds to the upper body. Authorities have identified the man as 20 year old Rayvion Alford of Shreveport.

Preliminary information gathered in the early stages of the investigation suggests Alford was shot while riding in a vehicle being operated by an acquaintance of his, when another vehicle, described as a dark colored pick up truck pulled alongside them and began firing. Alford, who was transported to Willis-Knighton Medical Center by private vehicle, is expected to recover from the injuries. Details surrounding the shooting are under review and investigators are working at this hour to determine who is responsible for the crime.
